Our Story

Paracombe is a family owned winery driven by heart, growing and making wines of provenance in the Adelaide Hills South Australia.

Our beginnings came from seeing opportunity. Rising from the ashes of the 1983 Ash Wednesday bushfires our founders, Paul and Kathy Drogemuller, planted a vineyard on a former dairy farm and made our first wines in a tin shed with a homemade basket press, secondhand milk tanks and crusher and boldly launched Paracombe Wines in 1992.

Over time we expanded our vineyards, designed and built a state of the art winery, underground cellars with a stunning cellar door boasting spectacular views. We've grown a dynamic team, including son Ben, who all share the obsession to make great wine that truly honours place. Paracombe Wines are enjoyed and well loved throughout Australia and the world.



Our Place

Our vineyard at Paracombe sits on an ancient 1.7 billion year old plateau, 425 metres above sea level. The geology here is remarkable and rare comprising Barossa Complex soils representing the oldest rocks in the Mount Lofty Ranges.

Our soils are lean and layered with ironstone, buckshot gravel and quartz, a deeply historic remnant from an ancient riverbed. Our vine roots grow deep, drawing up the minerals from underground spring water which along with minimal irrigation contribute a strong influence in wine style and flavour.

Our climate is cool, with warming sunshine during the day and temperature dropping at night granting slow, gentle ripening and rewarding in wines that offer lifted bouquets and superb fruit flavour, well balanced with natural acid.

Ecological Wine Growing and Making

We care deeply about the environment and being sustainable. We've taken important steps to minimise our impact by establishing a water recycling program and multiple solar panel systems on our winery roof.

Our vines are all hand pruned to keep yields low and quality high. We use organic composts and fertilizers, slash and mulch the grass under the vines for water retention, promoting worm activity and healthy soils.

Our cellar door facility was built using Eco Wall panels, an amazing product made from concrete covered, reconstituted polystyrene materials.

By growing the grapes, making, storing, bottling and distributing direct from the winery, we're contributing towards a cleaner and greener environment ensuring a better future for us all.



About Paracombe

Only 30 minutes from Adelaide, Paracombe township is located in the lofty heights of the Adelaide Hills. It was settled in 1840 as a sheep station at the beginning of the 20th century. The name originates from the Little Para River whose headwaters originate in the area and 'combe' refers to a steep, narrow valley. The Torrens River Gorge is nearby with magnificent rising slopes either side of the river as it converges onto the Adelaide plains below.

Paracombe is a patchwork of beauty, with vineyards and surrounding orchards all adding to the panoramic tapestry of the area.

Our Label

Our design of a single grape on a piece of stone is striking, memorable and portrays the highest level of quality and care we put into our vineyards.

Nestled on a plateau, the surrounding terrain is hilly with some parts being very steep. The piece of stone on which our grape sits represents the shape of our plateau taken from a contour map. Granite was chosen, as the colour and feel of granite is cool, signifying Paracombe's cool climate ideal for producing elegant and stylish wines.



Our Wine

The fruit for our wines comes from our vineyards and specialist local growers. Our strength is our diversity and the ability to produce a superb range featuring traditional favourites and emerging new varieties and styles. From sparkling, crisp aromatic whites, to medium bodied, elegant reds.

We respect what nature gives us and use gentle, minimal interventional style of winemaking. Our whites reflect varietal purity, our red wines see subtle, balanced oak use and cellar maturation prior to release.
