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Old vintage sparkling 2000: take you back to the year 2000. Made from 100% pinot noir grapes. Sense the aroma of oyster, honey, rose, and bread dough. Very small beads that fill our whole palate

T Sauvignon Blanc: fruit salad in a glass. . Ripe stone fruit, mango and green apple are plentiful with easy-going citrus notes providing a zippy finish.

Fume Blanc: Tropical notes of pineapple, melon and guava bounce out of the glass with licks of savoury nuttiness and faint herbal notes providing textural depth. Judicious use of oak leads to a more sophisticated expression of the Sauvignon Blanc grape

Field blend Rose: Aromas of rose petal and turkish delight give pink and perfume. A lick of lemongrass provides back-palate bite. Blend of pinot noir, sauvignon blanc, chardonnay and gerwustraminer. 100% natural, unfiltered, unfiltered

ese Pinot Noir 2019: Pinot with a punch! Juicy plum, ripe black cherry, and a whack of savoury spices dominate in this single site, Coal Valley, Pinot Noir. An incredibly more-ish and gutsy style of Tassie Pinot Noir

ese Pinot Noir 2013: A warmer and full bodied style of pinot, dark berry, forest floor, and mushroom. A must try pinot noir unlike others

Golden Goose piquette: Biodynamically grown, wild fermented. Lively and fresh, hibiscus flowers, rose water and a candied strawberry, bright pink , 7% abv, this is thirst quenching 'party starter' fizz!
